- ❖ I understand that drugs, alcohol, or tobacco are not allowed at any practices or games.
- ❖ I understand that coaches will not serve as “babysitters” before, during or after practices and/or games
- ❖ I will make sure that my player is on time for practices and games

Sideline coaching, negativity, yelling and screaming will only distract and confuse the players. At no time will a coach discuss a player’s performance or “playing time” with anyone other than the player’s parent, nor will “bad-mouthing” of another player from the sidelines be tolerated.
