Gallatin Environmental Services Customer,

As we wind down this busy season, and prepare for the new year, we would like to take this opportunity to remind you of some of our policies, in efforts to provide the most efficient and affordable solid waste disposal services possible.

### Garbage Service

- Cans must be to the road by 7 AM on the day of pickup.
- Cans must be placed with lids closed, handles facing away from the street, with minimum of 3' clear space in all directions.
- Customers own their garbage can, and are responsible to keep can in a serviceable condition, in order to allow us to provide service.

### Brush/Leaf Service

- Brush (this includes live Christmas trees) is picked up without calling. Pickup times vary depending on season, recent storm events, and timing of truck in route vs. timing of placement of brush. Brush routes average completion of route in 5 weeks.
- Leaves/yard waste must be placed in brown recyclable bags. They must be called in, and will be picked up the day after your regular curbside trash pickup.

### Bulk Item Pickup

- Items must be called in prior to Friday. Pickup occurs on Friday.
- Construction/building materials (including toilets, sinks, carpet, etc.), tires, dead animals and other items are not eligible for pickup.
